THE COLLEGE CO-OPERATIVE STORE.

The idea of starting a Co-operative Store in connection with the College originated with Babu Satyendra Nath De, M. Sc., an ex-student of the College, now a research scholar in Sir J. C. Bose's Instituté. He had made himself familiar with the principles and practice of Co-operative movement by putting himself in communication with Babu Nripendra Nath Bose, an officer of the Co-operative Society's Department, Bengal, who evidently with the permission of his chief and his encouragement, came and saw the principal with the object of having a store started in connection with the College. Babu Dakshina Ranjan Banerji, M. Sc., an ex-student of the College, now a Professor in the College and also the Resident Superintendent of the College-Hostel joined us at this time and on the 11th July last a meeting was called of all the Professors of the College and some of the semior students which resolved unanimously that a Society under the name "Bangabasi College Co-operative Store" be started and duly registered under the Co-operative Society Act. II. of 1912. The draft rules prepared beforehand by Babu Nripendra Nath Bose who was invited to be present at the meeting were approved by the meeting and other necessary formalities were gone through for the purpose of having the Store registered. A provisional Board of Directors was also formed. The Store has now been registered and me Certificate of Registration has been received:

Another meeting of the Store was held on the 12th August 1 18 at which the proceedings of the last meeting were confirmed.
