THE RESULTS.

The results of the Matriculation Examination were published in the Calcutta Gazette of the 24th October; they, however, appeared in some of the vernacular papers on an earlier date. 5879 have passed in the First Division, 4743 in the Second Division and 648 in the Third Division, bringing up the total to 11270.

The College School has passed 59 in all, namely, 37 in the First Division, 19 in the Second Division and 3 in the Third. Division.

We also reprint from our July issue the results of our College in the I. A., 1. Sc., B. A. and B. Sc. Examinations of 1917 for the information of the large number of students who have newly joined us.

At the Intermediate Examination in Science, the College has passed 91, the largest number passed by any Calcutta College, just as it was the case last year. Of these 46 have been placed, in the First, 41 in the Second and 4 in the Third Division.

At the Intermediate Examination in Arts, the College has passed 99, of whom 19 have been placed in the First, 57 in the Second and 23 in the Third Division.

At the B. Sc. Examination, the College has passed 21, of whom 8 have obtained Distinction.

At the B A. Examination, the College has passed 82, of whom two have obtained Honours in English and two in Mathematics, three have won Distinction and 75 have passed in the Pass Course.

On the results of the Intermediate Examinations, the Saradaprasad Prize in Botany has been awarded to Sriman Ashwinikumar Majumdar who passed the I. Sc. Examination in the First Division from this College.
