Among the recipients of the New Year's honours we are glad to find the name of Pandit Dr. Bhagbatkumar Sastri M. A. Ph. D., upon whom has been conferred the title of Maha-Mahopadhyaya, an honour which was long his due. Dr. Shastri was a brilliant member of our staff and left it for the emoluments of Government service. It is gratifying to see that his merits have been recognised both by the University and the Government. Recently he won the Doctorate in Philosophy for a thesis that evoked high praise from the examiners. We heartily congratulate Dr. Shastri on his receiving now the title of Maha-Mahopadhyaya.

We have also very great pleasure to record that Professor Pramadacharan Mazumdar of our College who was a Corporal in the University Training Corps has been raised to the position of Second Lieutenant and has been granted the King's Commission. We hope higher honours are in store for Prof. Mazumdar.

Our College has stood first in the Inter-Collegiate Boat Race Competition of this year, held under the auspices of the Calcutta University Institute. Sreeman Radhanath Banerjee of 2nd year section C, is to be congratulated for the able way in which he captained his college team. We are sorry that as all the six students who took part in the competition and formed our College team are appearing at the I. Sc. We congratulate Sjt. Ramesh Chandra Bhattacharyya of the 4th year B. Sc. on his obtaining the 2nd prize in *Ussraj* in the Inter-Collegiate Music Competition of this year.
