

IN MEMORIAM.

It is with a heavy heart that we have to record the sudden death of Rai Abinash Chandra Bose Bahadur, Controller of Examinations and a member of the Senate, Calcutta University. The Rai Bahadur went to Mihijam for a change and came back to Calcutta on Friday, the 10th December, to attend the Senate-meeting on Saturday, the 11th December. While passing through the passage leading to Western Hall he fell down and expired almost immediately. Death was due to heart-failure.

The late Rai Bahadur was a distinguished scholar, and had a uniformly brilliant University career. After his retirement from Government service he was appointed Controller of Examinations, Calcutta University, in the year 1917, which post he held with credit. He was sixty-two years old at the time of his death. We offer our sincerest condolence to the bereaved family. As a mark of respect to the memory of the deceased our College remained closed on Monday, the 13th December.

Bose as its President and Messrs Satyananda Roy and Indranarayan Mookerjee as its Secretaries for the purpose of raising funds to perpetuate the memory of the deceased.
