

THE ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION:

SESSION—1929.

The first meeting of the above Association was held on Wednesday the 6th March, 1929, in Room no 4 at 10. 30A. M. Prof. D. N. Mookherjee was in the chair. The object of the meeting was to elect the office-bearers for the current session.

The following were declared duly elected :—

President—Prof. D. N. Mookherjee.

Hony. Secretary—Sj. Panchu Gopal Chatterjee.

Hony. Asst. Secretary—Sj. Sudhir Kumar Ghosh.

Hony. Treasurer—Sj. Pankajendra Mookherjee.

The President then nominated the following members as constituting the Executive Committee :—

(4) Sj Jatindra Nath Das.

An emergent meeting of the Executive Committee was held on the 7th March, 1929, in the Botanical Laboratory to consider the application of the Literary Board through Sj. Kshirode Kumar Bhattacharjee and the lower two shelves were lent for the use of the Literary Board until it could procure one.

As there were no permanent rules and regulations of the Economics Association and the Association Library, the Executive met for the second time in the Library room on Monday the 1st March, 1929, to draft rules and regulations for the College Economics Association and the Association Library and also considered the rate of subscriptions to be raised from the students.

A second general meeting was called, on Wednesday the 20th March, 1929. As the President of this Association could not be duly informed Prof. P. M. Sen Gupta presided. The attendance was thin. The agenda of the day was the election of two Vice-Presidents and also due consideration of the rules and regulations drafted by the Executive Committee.

Prof. N. N. Sen Gupta, Professor of Logic of this College, formerly Professor of politics was proposed by Sudhir Ghose and was elected unanimously.

Sj. Sailendra Das a student of Economics was proposed by P. C. Chatterjee and was elected unanimously.

The rules and regulations as drafted by the Executive Committee were proposed and adopted unaniously except one or two disputed points which have been reserved for another general meeting as the President had to leave the meeting earlier owing to a previous engagement.
